

Appeal Bonds – Bonds that secure release during an appeal of a conviction.

Appearance Bonds – Bonds that secure release after an arrest and during a trial.

Cash Bonds - Defendant pays cash for the bail amount. Not really a bond.

Immigration Bonds - Bonds securing release while on trial for illegal immigration.

Misdemeanor Bonds - Bonds securing release of a misdemeanor offender.

Signature Bonds - Bonds secured by an individual or defendant using only their personal guarantee.

Surety Bonds - A bail bond sold by a licensed bail agent representing the surety company. It ensures the defendant that he or she will appear in court and answer to the accusation brought against him or her.

Traffic Bonds - Bond guaranteeing the appearance of the defendant accused of a vehicle code violation.
